An Act relative to the release of sex offender information to victims.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 178I of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the second paragraph, the following:—  
3   Upon the request of a victim who has enrolled in the board’s victim services unit, the board shall  
4   inform the victim of the sex offender’s final classification, as well as the sex offender’s home  
5   address, secondary address, work address and where the offender attends school.
