## The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to traffic direction.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 6B of Chapter 40 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,
- 2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:--
- A city or town which accepts this section shall require uniforms, for the uniformed
- 4 members of its police force purchased using appropriated funds, to include a pair of white gloves
- 5 for use while directing traffic. Members of said police force shall wear white gloves at all times
- 6 when directing traffic.
