**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to increasing killed-in-line-of-duty benefits for public safety employees.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (c). Section 100A of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
2 official 2014 edition, is hereby amended by striking the word “\$150,000” in line 9 and inserting
3 in place thereof :- \$500,000.

4 Subsection (d). Section 100A of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
5 official 2014 edition, is hereby amended by striking the word “\$150,000” in line 24 and inserting
6 in place thereof :- \$500,000.

7 Subsection (e). Section 100A of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
8 official 2014 edition, is hereby amended by striking the word “\$150,000” in line 35 and inserting
9 in place thereof :- \$500,000.

10 Subsection (f). Section 100A of Chapter 32 of the General Laws, as appearing in the
11 official 2014 edition, is hereby amended by striking the word “\$150,000” in line 37 and inserting
12 in place thereof :- \$500,000.
