An Act relative to the retirement benefits of state police dispatchers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           "SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 32 of the General Laws is hereby amended by  
2 inserting after the word "Authority" in line 266 the following:- "employees of the State Police  
3 working as State Police Dispatchers in groups SPD 1, 2, and 3 who have ben employed in a such  
4 a capacity for 10 years or more.""
