**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to a senior exemption for the town of Harwich.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding the provisions of clause 41C of section 5 of chapter 59 of
2 the General Laws, or of any other general or special law to the contrary, the Board of Assessors
3 in the town of Harwich is hereby authorized to grant a senior exemption in the amount of
4 \$1,500.00 to individuals meeting the qualifications contained in clause 41C of section 5 of
5 chapter 59.

6 SECTION 2. In the fiscal year in which this act takes effect, the town of Harwich is
7 hereby authorized to reimburse those eligible for a senior exemption under clause 41C of section
8 5 of chapter 59 of the General Laws in the amount of \$500.00.

9 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
