Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1. Section 39M of Chapter 30 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
- 2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting the following paragraph at the end thereof:-
- 3 "In order to ensure the timely and consistent payment for police details assigned to
- 4 public works projects performed under this chapter, the project awarding authority shall assume
- 5 direct responsibility for maintaining police detail records, receiving invoices from, and making
- 6 direct payments to those entities providing such paid details. The cost of police details shall not
- 7 be included as part of the bid submitted by any offerer responding to a bid solicitation conducted
- 8 in accordance with this chapter. This paragraph shall be referenced or included as part of the bid
- 9 documents for public works projects."
