An Act concerning energy efficient improvements.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The General Laws are hereby amended to establish, under Chapter 23M,
2 and through the Massachusetts Development Finance Agency, as established in chapter 23G, and
3 the department of energy resources, as established in chapter 25A, a residential sustainable
4 energy program to provide financing to residential property owners for energy efficient and
5 renewable energy improvements.
