An Act relative to motor vehicle excise taxes.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 90 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-

2 Section 61. If a license plate is returned to the registry of motor vehicles for any motor  
3 vehicle subject to the motor vehicle excise tax established in section 1 of chapter 60A, the  
4 registry of motor vehicles shall notify the assessor in the municipality where the motor vehicle  
5 was registered. When a license plate is returned to the registry of motor vehicles for any motor  
6 vehicle subject to the motor vehicle excise tax established in section 1 of chapter 60A, the  
7 registry of motor vehicles shall provide documentation to the person returning the license plate  
8 indicating they have returned the plate to the registry of motor vehicles. This documentation  
9 shall constitute prima facie evidence of the return of the license plate. No additional excise tax  
10 shall accrue on the motor vehicle once the license plate has been returned.
