**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to charter school renewal.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Subsection (dd) of section 89 of chapter 71 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by chapter 283 of the acts of 2014, is hereby further amended by inserting
3 after the first sentence, the following clause:-

4 ; provided, however, that the term for a charter school renewal shall be 7 years from the
5 expiration of the initial charter or subsequent renewals.
