An Act allowing a service branch designation on license plates for disabled veterans.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2 official edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 415 after the word “VETERAN.”:–“The  
3 Registrar shall furnish, without charge, a “VETERAN” plate or general issue plate at the request  
4 of an operator who is eligible for a Disabled Veteran plate pursuant to this section,”

5           SECTION 2. Section 2 of chapter 90 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
6 official edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 453 after the word “who”:–“is eligible for  
7 a Disabled Veteran plate pursuant to this section or”
