An Act relative to the traffic commission in the city of Woburn.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. The second sentence of section 4 of chapter 103 of the acts of 2005 is  
2 hereby amended by striking out the words “shall take effect until published for 2 successive  
3 weeks in 1 or more newspapers of general circulation in the city” and inserting in its place the  
4 following words “shall take effect until approved by the city council under section 6, and filed in  
5 the office of the city clerk”.

6           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
