An Act exempting certain uniformed positions in the fire department of the city of Marlborough from the civil service law.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, all uniformed  
2 positions in the fire department of the City of Marlborough below the rank of Fire Chief,  
3 including assistant fire chiefs, deputy fire chiefs, fire captains, fire lieutenants, and fire fighters  
4 shall be exempt from the provisions of chapter 31 of the General Laws.

5 SECTION 2. This act shall not impair the civil service status of a person holding a  
6 position described in section 1 on the effective date of this act.

7 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
