An Act relative to licensing group care facilities serving students with special needs.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Section 1. Section 1A of chapter 15D of the General Laws is hereby amended in the
- 2 definition of “Group care facility” by adding in the second sentence after the words “children
- 3 with special needs” the following: “, including children with special needs under the age of 22.
