1           SECTION 1. Section 1D of chapter 69 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2010  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in line 6, after the words “science and  
3   technology,” the following words:- “computer science and computational thinking, including  
4   computer coding,”
