An Act prohibiting ballot question contributions by certain businesses.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 6B of chapter 55 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by adding the following paragraph:- A ballot question committee shall not  
3 receive money or other things of value from a business or professional corporation, partnership,  
4 limited liability company or limited liability partnership, or any subsidiary thereof, which has a  
5 contract with the commonwealth in an amount greater than \$50,000.
