An Act relative to kidnapping as a sexual offense.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 178C of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out in line 72 the words, “kidnapping of a child
3 under section 26 of said chapter 265;”, and further by striking out in lines 112 to 113, inclusive,
4 the words, “kidnapping of a child under the age of 16 under section 26 of said chapter 265;”

5 SECTION 2. Section 178E of said chapter 6, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is
6 hereby amended by inserting before the words, “ or if the sex offender”, in line 166, the
7 following clause:- has been convicted of a kidnapping under section 26 of chapter 265 that
8 included an element that was sexual in nature
