## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to the marijuana tax rate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. The secretary of the executive office of administration and finance, in
2	conjunction with the treasurer and receiver general, shall create a commission to review the
3	existing tax rate structure to be imposed upon the sale of marijuana or marijuana products by a
4	marijuana retailer to anyone other than a marijuana establishment. The commission may make
5	recommendations relative to adjusting the recreational marijuana tax structure.
6	SECTION 2. The secretary of the office of administration and finance shall file a report
7	with the both branches of the legislature, the joint committee on revenue, the house committee
8	on ways and means and the senate committee on ways and means by September 1, 2017 with
9	their recommendations.
