**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act for fair competition in the sale of recreational marijuana.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 3: Said Chapter 94G is hereby further amended by striking out section 10, as
2 appearing in the 2016 Official Edition, and inserting in place thereof the following section:-

3 Section 10. The commission shall begin accepting applications:

4 a. For marijuana testing facility licenses, by March 1, 2018

5 b. From all applicants for marijuana retailer, marijuana product manufacturer, and
6 marijuana cultivator licenses, by March 1, 2018
