An Act banning the manufacture and sale of edible marijuana.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: Chapter 334 of the Acts of 2016 is hereby amended in SECTION 5  
2 subsection 3(l) by the striking out the words:- “edible products, beverages”

3           SECTION 2: Chapter 94C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 official edition,  
4 is hereby amended by adding the following section:

5           Section 32O: Any person who knowingly or intentionally manufactures, distributes,  
6 dispenses, or possesses with intent to manufacture, distribute or dispense any product or additive  
7 which can be ingested as an edible form of marijuana containing active THC shall be subject to  
8 section 34 of this chapter.
