**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to recreational facilities and zoning.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 3 of Chapter 40A of the General Laws, is hereby amended by
2 inserting in paragraph 2 at the end after the word “utilities” the following sentences:-

3 “In order for a nonprofit educational corporation to qualify under this section, the primary
4 or dominant use must be for an educational purpose. Furthermore, recreational facilities shall not
5 qualify under this section.”
