*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Section	n 328 of Chapter	94 of the General	Laws as appearin	g in the 2014

2 Official Edition is hereby amended by inserting, in line 1, before the words "No person", the

4	For the purpose of this section, the term "person" shall mean an individual, corporation,
5	partnership, organization, association, or governmental entity, including a retail grocer,
6	wholesaler, hotel, motel, manufacturer, restaurant, caterer, farmer, and nonprofit food distributor
7	or hospital. In the case of a corporation, partnership, organization, association, or governmental
8	entity, the term includes an officer, director, partner, deacon, trustee, council member, or other
9	elected or appointed individual responsible for the governance of the entity; as defined by
10	Paragraph (10) of Subsection (b) of Section 1791 of Chapter 13A of the 2015 United States
11	Code, also known as the Bill Emerson Good Samaritan Food Donation Act.
