An Act relative the Massachusetts military asset and security strategy task force membership.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1: Section 216 of chapter 6 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014  
2   Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting after the words “the commander of the  
3   Massachusetts air national guard or a designee;”, in line 8, as amended by section 3 of chapter 48  
4   of the acts of 2014, the following words:- the district commander of the U. S. coast guard first  
5   district or a designee;.
