An Act relative to the retirement benefits of certain employees at the Department of Children and Families.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 1. Section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws as appearing in the 2006 Official  
2           Edition is hereby amended by inserting after the word prisoners in line 252 the following words:-  
  
3           employees of the Department of Children and Families holding the position of  
4           Community Resource Developer A/B or C, Case Reviewer A/B, and Special Investigator DSS  
5           A/B or equivalent or successive titles who have been employed in such capacities or other DCF  
6           Group 2 titles for 10 years of more.
