1           Section 6 of chapter 64H of the General Laws , as appearing in the 2010 Official edition,  
2 is hereby amended by adding the following subsection:-

3           (yy) Any retail sale, as defined by this chapter, made within 10 miles of the New  
4 Hampshire border.
