## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to the film tax credit.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the
2	department of revenue shall not accept any applications for exemptions from the sales tax from a
3	motion picture production company under subsection (ww) of section 6 of chapter 64H after
4	June 30, 2018.
5	SECTION 2. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the
6	department of revenue shall not allow a credit under subsection (l) of section 6 of chapter 62 or
7	under section 38X of chapter 63 for any total aggregate payroll or production expense, as those
8	terms are used in subsection (1) of section 6 of chapter 62 and in section 38X of chapter 63,
9	incurred after June 30, 2019.".
