**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act further regulating the Assisted Living Advisory Council.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 17 of chapter 19D of the general laws, as appearing in the 2014
2 Official Edition, is hereby amended by inserting in the third sentence, after the words “consumer
3 interests,” the following: one of whom shall be a representative of the Massachusetts Assisted
4 Living Association, Inc.,

5 SECTION 2. Section 17 of chapter 19D of the general laws, as appearing in the 2016
6 Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking in the fifth sentence the words: - “of one year
7 each,” and inserting in place thereof, the words: - coterminous with the governor. Vacancies
8 shall be filled in the same manner as the original appointment for the remainder of any unexpired
9 term.”
