An Act relative to complimentary drinking water at establishments serving alcohol.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 138 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the following section:-
- 2 Section 90. A licensee who serves alcoholic beverages pursuant to this chapter shall
- 3 provide water to any patron without charge upon request.
