An Act relative to the privacy of lottery winners.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Chapter 10 of the General Laws is hereby amended by inserting after section 28B the  
2 following section:-

3 Section 28C. If the person entitled to a prize or any winning ticket wishes to remain  
4 anonymous, the director shall permit such person to claim such prize or winning ticket without  
5 the disclosure of such person’s name to the public and the director shall not require such person  
6 to participate in a press conference.
