An Act honoring Bob Cousy.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The section of Causeway street in the city of Boston running alongside TD Garden,  
2 between Portland street and Haverhill street, shall hereby be designated and known Bob Cousy  
3 Way, in honor of Boston Celtics legend Bob Cousy, known as “Mr. Basketball”, for his role in  
4 saving the sport of professional basketball by transforming the game into to one of crowd appeal.  
5 The Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain suitable markers  
6 bearing the designation on Causeway street in proximity to the entrance of TD Garden, in  
7 compliance with the standards of the department.
