Lewis relative to prohibiting the Department of Environmental Protection from issuing incineration operating permits in the vicinity of certain schools and parks. **In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act protecting schools in an in incineration zone.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of environmental protection under its operating permit and compliance
2 program (310 CMR 7.00: Appendix C) may not issue an operating permit that is within 0.5 miles
3 of a preschool, a K-12 school, youth sports field, or park. For purposes of this act “host
4 community” shall mean the municipality where the applicant seeks to locate the proposed
5 facility.
