The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act limiting executive salaries of state funded nonprofit organizations and public charities.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 180 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding the
- 2 following section:

3	Section 30. (a) A nonprofit corporation incorporated under the laws of the
4	commonwealth and subject to this chapter or a public charity holding funds subject to the
5	provisions of section 8 of chapter 12 that receives any public funds from the commonwealth
6	equal to or greater than 30 per cent of such nonprofit or public charity's yearly budget shall be
7	subject to the provisions of this section; provided, however that a non-profit hospital corporation
8	organized under chapter 176A shall not be subject to this section.

9	(b) The annual compensation of the executive staff of a nonprofit corporation or public
10	charity governed by this section shall be limited based on the annual budget size of the
11	organization and executive positions as follows:

SECTION 3. A nonprofit corporation incorporated under the laws of the commonwealth
and subject to this chapter or a public charity holding funds subject to the provisions of section 8
of chapter 12 found in violation of Section 30 (b) of this chapter shall lose its status as a nonprofit as it is organized and operates under the general laws.
SECTION 4. Subsection (b) of section 30 of chapter 180 of the General Laws shall take
