An Act relative to potluck events.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Chapter 94 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby  
2 further amended by inserting after section 328A the following section:-

3           Section 328B. No community-based senior nutrition program that regularly distributes  
4 food in any form to a residential dwelling, for the care of individuals who are elderly, shall be  
5 subject to regulation by the department of public health or any local board of health regarding the  
6 preparation and distribution of such food.
