An Act relative to the electronic deposit of tax refunds.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           Section 85 of chapter 62C of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014 Official Edition,  
2 is hereby amended by inserting after the second sentence the following sentence:- For refunds  
3 processed electronically and paid through direct deposit, the commissioner shall permit a  
4 taxpayer to elect to have his or her refund split and deposited into no more than 2 bank accounts,  
5 including, but not limited to higher education savings plans or accounts.
