In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act to ensure teen safety.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 112 Section 12F of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
2	Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the third paragraph.
3	SECTION 2. Chapter 112 Section 12S of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2014
4	Official Edition, is hereby amended by striking out the second paragraph and inserting in place
5	thereof the following paragraph:
6	The said consent form and any other forms, transcript of evidence, or written findings and
7	conclusions of a court, shall be confidential and may not be released to any person except by the
8	pregnant woman's written informed consent or by a proper judicial order, other than to the
9	pregnant woman herself, to whom such documents relate, the operating physician, or any person
