An Act relative to local control of boat excise revenue.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Subsection (i) of section 2 of chapter 60B of the General Laws, as  
2 appearing in the 2014 Official Edition, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the  
3 following sentence:- A city or town may change the per cent of said excise that is credited to its  
4 municipal waterways improvement and maintenance fund by a vote of its legislative body;  
5 provided, however, that a legislative body shall not decrease the excise credited to its municipal  
6 waterways improvement and maintenance fund below fifty per cent.
