An Act designating a bench in memory of Ambrose Valentino.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           The department of conservation and recreation shall designate a certain area or site within  
2 Toohig Park in the Dorchester section of the city of Boston, in the memory of Ambrose  
3 Valentino. The department shall consult with the Valentino and Mancuso families to design and  
4 designate a suitable marker that may include, but is not limited to, a bench, kiosk or memorial  
5 stone, which the department shall erect and maintain in compliance with the standards of the  
6 department.
