- 3 Section 33C. A city or town, that accepts this section in the manner provided in section 4
- 4 of chapter 4, may permit licensees holding all alcoholic beverages or only wines and malt
- 5 beverages to be served and drunk on the premises licenses, to sell the beverages, as the case may
- 6 be, at a discounted price; provided, however, that the beverages are listed at a discounted price at
- 7 least 3 week days between Sunday to Wednesday, inclusive.
