An Act relative to the employment contract for the Director of Public Works in the town of Upton.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1           The first paragraph of section 1 of chapter 263 of the acts of 1989 is hereby amended by
- 2   adding the following sentence:- The board of selectmen may enter into an employment contract
- 3   with the director for a period not to exceed 3 years.
