**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act designating a portion of Route 3 as the Middlesex 3 highway.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 445 of the acts of 1956, is hereby amended by striking out lines 1
2 through XX and inserting in its place thereof the following:

3 The section of U.S. highway route 3 beginning at its intersection with interstate highway
4 95 / state route 128 in the town of Burlington and ending at the New Hampshire state line, in
5 both directions, shall be designated and known as the Middlesex 3 Highway, in honor of the
6 Middlesex 3 Coalition for their commitment to improving economic activity along the corridor.
7 The Massachusetts Department of Transportation shall erect and maintain suitable markers
8 bearing the designation in compliance with the standards of the department.
