**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act authorizing the town of Whately to continue the employment of John Lasalle as a call firefighter.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, John LaSalle, a
2 call firefighter for the town of Whately, may continue in the position until he reaches 70 years of
3 age, the date of his retirement or until his non-reappointment, whichever first occurs; provided,
4 however, that deductions from the regular compensation of John LaSalle shall not be made under
5 chapter 32 of the General Laws for any service subsequent to his reaching the age of 65 in
6 connection with his service to the town for retirement or pension purposes.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
