Martone to the position of firefighter in the town of North Andover, notwithstanding the maximum age requirement. Public Service. [Local Approval Received.]

An Act exempting Nicholas L. Martone from the maximum age requirement for firefighters in the Town of North Andover.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding sections 58, 61A and 61B of Chapter 31 of the General
2 Laws or any General or Special law to the contrary, Nicholas L. Martone may have his name
3 certified for original appointment to the position of firefighter in the Town of North Andover,
4 notwithstanding having reached the age of 32 before taking any civil service examination in
5 connection with such appointment. In all other respects, Nicholas L. Martone shall be eligible for
6 appointment to the position of fire fighter in the Town of North Andover only insofar as he
7 qualifies and is selected for employment under Chapter 31 of the General Laws, any regulations
8 of the Civil Service Commission and any lawful hiring practices of the Town of North Andover.
9 This exemption shall apply only to the certified lists assembled under the examination conducted
10 prior to the adoption of this act.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
