Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- SECTION 1: Chapter 388 of the Acts of 2010 is hereby amended by adding the
- 2 following section: --
- 3 SECTION 1A: The licensing authority of the Town of Belmont shall not approve the
- 4 transfer of a license granted under this act, or under chapter 14 of the acts of 2004, to any other
- 5 location or to any other person, partnership, corporation, LLC, organization or any other entity.
- 6 SECTION 2. Chapter 15 of the Acts of 2014 is hereby amended by adding the following
- 7 section: --
- 8 SECTION 1A: The licensing authority of the Town of Belmont shall not approve the
- 9 transfer of a license granted under this act, or under chapter 128 of the acts of

- 10 1997, to any other location or to any other person, partnership, corporation, LLC,
- 11 organization or any other entity.
- SECTION 3: This act shall take effect upon its passage.
