An Act to amend special legislation to limit transfer of restaurant liquor licenses in the town of Belmont.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1: Chapter 16 of the Acts of 2014 is hereby amended by adding the following  
2 section: --

3 . SECTION 2A: The licensing authority of the Town of Belmont shall not approve the  
4 transfer of a license granted under this act, or under chapters

5 395 or 396 of the acts of 2006, to any other location or to any other

6 . person, partnership, corporation, LLC, organization or any other entity.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
