By Representative Pignatelli of Lenox and Senator Hinds, a joint petition (accompanied by bill, House, No. 3833) of Smitty Pignatelli and Adam G. Hinds (by vote of the town) that the town of Lenox be authorized to convey a conservation restriction on certain parcels of land. Municipalities and Regional Government. [Local Approval Received.]

The Commonwealth of Alassachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act authorizing the town of Lenox to convey a conservation restriction on certain parcels of land.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, the town of
- 2 Lenox, acting by and through its board of selectmen acting as the board of water commissioners,
- 3 may convey to the town of Lenox, acting by and through its conservation commission, and to
- 4 Berkshire Natural Resources Council, Inc., for no consideration, a perpetual conservation
- 5 restriction under section 31, 32 and 33 of chapter 184 of the General Laws, for the preservation
- of water supply, fish and wildlife conservation, native habitat protection, forest management,
- 7 passive recreation and other consistent purposes in certain parcels of land identified in section 2,
- 8 upon such terms and conditions as the board of selectmen, acting as the board of water
- 9 commissioners, shall determine to be appropriate.
- SECTION 2. The parcels of land pursuant to section 1 are identified as follows: all of the
- lands in the town of Lenox recorded in certain orders of taking and deeds in the Berkshire middle

- district registry of deeds in book 531, page 545, excepting property described in book 588, page
- 8; book 848, page 384; book 558, page 245; book 636, page 591; book 644, page 338 and book
- 14 657, page 188; book 1201, page 913 and book 5880, page 148.
- SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
