**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act relative to registered voters.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 51, Section 26 of the General Laws is hereby amended by adding
2 the following language to the end of this section, “If any such person was previously registered
3 in another community within the Commonwealth immediately preceding the filing of this new
4 registration, such person shall be allowed to vote in that community for that regular or special
5 preliminary, primary or election for state elections only.”

6 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon passage.
