An Act authorizing the town of Provincetown to continue the employment of Michael Trovato.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, Michael  
2 Trovato, a member of the fire department of the town of Provincetown, may continue to serve in  
3 such position until May 31, 2024, until the date of his retirement, or until the date he is relieved  
4 of his duties by the Board of Fire Engineers, whichever occurs first; provided, however, that he  
5 is mentally and physically capable of performing the duties of his office. The town may, at its  
6 own expense, require that Michael Trovato be examined by an impartial physician designated by  
7 them to determine such capability.

8           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
