**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court  
(2017-2018)**

An Act eliminating the preliminary election in the City of Revere in 2017.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1           SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any general or special law to the contrary, there shall be no  
2 preliminary election in the city of Revere as otherwise required on September 12, 2017 for either  
3 the office of school committee for a 2-year term or for the office of city council for a 2-year  
4 term. All candidates whose nomination papers have been duly certified shall be deemed to have  
5 been nominated and their names shall appear on the general election ballot.

6           SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
