In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act relative to Mosquito Control.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1	Section 2 of chapter 252 of the General Laws, as appearing in the 2016 Official Edition,
2	is hereby amended by striking out the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the following
3	sentence:-
4	One employee of the department of environmental protection designated by its
5	commissioner, one employee of the department of agricultural resources designated by its
6	commissioner, one employee of the department of conservation and recreation designated by its
7	commissioner, one employee of the department of fish and game designated by its
8	commissioner, and one employee of the department of public health designated by its
9	commissioner, shall constitute the state reclamation and mosquito control board, in this chapter
10	called the board.
