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**In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court
(2017-2018)**

An Act to support voluntary income tax assistance sites and expand access to the earned income tax credit.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Notwithstanding any general or special law or regulation to the contrary and subject to
- 2 appropriation, the department of revenue shall operate a program to support organizations
- 3 providing tax assistance services to individuals and families qualifying for the federal Volunteer
- 4 Income Tax Assistance Program in the provision of those services.
