## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the One Hundred and Ninetieth General Court (2017-2018)

An Act amending the charter of the city of Malden.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:* 

1	SECTION 1. Section 9 of Chapter 169 of the Acts of 1881 is hereby amended by striking
2	out sentence 8 and inserting in place thereof the following:-

3	"The members elect of the city council and school committee and when applicable the
4	mayor elect shall, on the first Monday of the New Year, meet in convention, when the oath
5	required by this act shall be administered to the members of those boards present, by the mayor
6	or by any justice of the peace; and a certificate of such oath having been taken shall be entered
7	upon the journals of the respective boards, by their clerks; provided that in any year where the
8	first Monday in January is a legal holiday the city council may choose an alternate date to fall
9	within the first eight (8) days of the New Year."

10 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
